



Considering the huge volume of work and the sensitivity involved, in slight modification of the earlier Standing Order No.50/2005,it has been decided that , all post shipment minor amendments, which do not result in any increase in post-export benefit and do not have any revenue implications, are henceforth delegated to the concerned ACs / DCs.

However in case of the major post- shipment amendments, those involving change in the followings, such as 1.Quantity or Value, 2. Name of the Exporter/ Consignee, 3. Rate of duty / Sl. No. of DBK/DEPB Schedules ,4. License No., prior approval of the concerned ADC / JC has to be sought, before issuance of any amendment certificate.

All the concerned AC/DC are directed to follow the above guidelines scrupulously.
