## **GENERAL COMMISSIONERATE**

3. Shri Krishana Kumar Prasad, Additional Commissioner of Customs, JNCH started the discussion on the agenda points of the meeting related to the General Commissionerate.

### **I. AGENDA POINTS RAISED BY BCBA**

#### **1) Extension of validity of Self Sealing and Self Permission for Exporters**

We would like to draw your kind attention to J.N. Public Notice No. 143/2020 dated 10.12.2020 through which the validity of Self-Sealing Permissions updated in the ED/ System up to 31/12/2023.

In view of endeavour of Govt. of India for "Ease of Doing Business" and to curb the increase in the dwell time for clearance and transaction cost, we request you to kindly allow to increase the validity of the same, as per Para 3 of J. N. Public Notice No.159/2016 dated 28.11.2016, on Suo Moto Basis. We request you to kindly issue a Public Notice in the said regards for the benefit of trade.

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair stated that the Department is in the process of revisiting the PN- 143/2020 dated 10.12.2020 and feedback from trade are invited.**

### **II. AGENDA POINTS RAISED BY CSLA**

- 1) Improper generation of EGM acknowledgment (without error / shipping bill wise validation status) in ICEGATE 2.0 version – The EGM acknowledgment file generated in 2.0 version doesn't contains shipping bill wise validation / error status which creates difficulty to track how many shipping bills have been validated successfully and how many have been rejected with errors. In absence of proper acknowledgment, The EGM error regularization process by exporter / shipping line is delayed. ICEGATE should be requested to generate a proper acknowledgment file with shipping bill wise validation status in 2.0 version also similar to the acknowledgement being generated in 1.5 version.

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair directed to provide all the details/data to ADC/EDI so that the matter can be taken up with DG System/ICEGATE.**

### **III. AGENDA POINTS RAISED BY CFSAI**

#### **1) Issuance of Damage Report from BMCT**

As informed earlier, BMCT is not providing the EIR Copy with damage container remarks in the "Damage Report" prior the container is gated out from the Terminal . Informatively other Terminals GTI, NSICT/NSIGT & NSFT provide the EIR copy for any damages observed in the damage report before the container is moved out from the Terminal.

"Damage Report" when Container leaves terminal is needed by CFSs to prove that the damage happened before the container is brought to CFS. Otherwise, CFSs can be held responsible and liable for the damage costs by the Shipping Lines when empties are returned. In case of Reefer Containers, the damage cost is normally very high.

BMCT may please be advised to follow & adopt the same practice as observed by other Terminals.

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair stated that whatever practice is being followed by other terminals, BMCT too is to follow the same.**

#### **2) BARC NOC for disposal/destruction of imported biodegradable goods by in-situ composting**

The procedure of destruction of certain perishable cargoes by in-situ by a biodegradable process developed by BARC process has been in place since 2015-16. The present BARC management is not willing to continue providing services, despite the fact that proper SOP for this activity, prepared by BARC is in place. JNCH had kindly assisted and arranged two tripartite meetings (JNCH-BARC-CFSA) in last 4 months.

BARC had Initially proposed for a "Technology Transfer" to CFSAI for which the required details was furnished to BARC on 2nd May 2023. BARC have now informed that the Technology Transfer committee and the concerned approving authority have not accepted the proposal & the same needs to go to MOU Committee. Further to take this forward BARC had advised that if JNCH initiates the proposal and writes to BARC, being a Central Government regulatory authority under whose instructions/directions the cargoes need to be destroyed, BARC may consider the proposal.

We seek the support of JNCH in resolving this issue by formally taking up with BARC

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair stated that transfer of Technology is BARC's prerogative, however our department is trying to arrange a meeting with BARC officials to resolve the issue.**

## EXPORT COMMISSIONERATE

4. Ms. Usha Nilkanth Bhojar, Joint Commissioner of Customs, JNCH started the discussion on the agenda points of the meeting related to the Export Commissionerate.

(I) **Agenda points proposed by Brihanmumbai Custom Brokers Association (BCBA): -**

1) **Delay in clearance of Export consignments at all CFS**

As We would like to bring to your notice that members are facing tremendous difficulty in clearance of export consignments due to delay being experienced at all CFS's. Since past few days, LEO's are delayed, resulting to shut outs of the Shipments on the planned vessel. We request to kindly monitor the export clearances at various CFS's in larger interest of Export Trade at JNCH.

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair stated that public notice has already been issued for double shift working in JWR CFS and Conex CFS and instructions have been given to the officers to take 2-3 rounds for examination of goods.**

2) **Request for amendment of Process laid down in Public Notice No.01/2023 dated 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 for Back to Town**

Clearance of al/ factory stuffed containers is processed at the CPP and subsequently containers are gated inside their respective terminal. Similarly, clearance of al/ dock stuffed containers is processed from the custom bonded premises and subsequently stuffed in containers and duly sealed with Custom Seals and are gated inside their respective terminal.

Registration & LEO is granted after all due verification & compliance of RMS instructions. Hence, all the requisite compliances have been done prior to grant of LEO.

In view of the same, we request you not to subject such cargo / containers to 100 % Examination (as al/ the compliance / examination if mandated by RMS was already done) but to restore allow of BTT (from CPP or Port) on "Sea/ Intact" verification methodology as mentioned in PN 36 / 2004 so as to avoid further increase the transaction cost for a cancelled shipment.

**प्रतिक्रिया/Response: The Chair stated that in this regard, a Public Notice is going to be issued shortly. Draft Public notice has been circulated seeking comments and inputs /feedback from trade members.**

5. The members of the meeting were informed that the mode and date of conducting next PTFC meeting shall be informed well in advance. **All the Association members were requested to forward their agenda points, if any, at least 07 working days in advance by e-mail to Appraising Main (Export) Section on [apmainexp@jawaharcustoms.gov.in](mailto:apmainexp@jawaharcustoms.gov.in) for taking up the issue in the upcoming PTFC meeting.**
