Attention is drawn to [Facility Notice No.13/2008](#), dated 4th Feb.2008, issued from F. NO. S/V-30/MISC-49/2007 CSD/ JNCH.The Managers/Executives/personnel of all Container Freight Stations, under the jurisdiction of JNCH, are hereby directed to follow the procedures, mentioned below w.r.t the suspected scanned containers.

- 1) On the basis of the suspected images of the scanned containers, presently, the CFS personnel are directed to put certain scanned containers reporting at their respective CFS under the hold of CSD. In such cases, NOC should be obtained from CSD who issues the same after examination of the goods /verification of documents etc..

- 2) Directions are also being given to the CFS personnel, through Official e-mail, that certain scanned containers which have not been examined by CSD are also required to be brought to the notice of the AC (Docks) concerned, before clearance. A common list of such containers is presently e-mailed to all the CFS, for information. The concerned Freight Stations are then asked to submit a hard copy of the same e-mail to the respective AC (Docks). AC (Docks) would take necessary action, as he deems it fit, for clearance of these containers. However, in these cases, NOC is not required to be obtained from CSD.In all such cases the CFS shall give the seal cutting permission only after written directions from the jurisdictional DC/AC.

◆◆◆◆◆ In addition, whenever a container is presented for examination to Customs, the ◆◆◆◆◆ CFSs are also required to inform the AC (Docks) whether the container has been scanned or not.
