This is to inform all concerned that the CSD (Container Scanning Division) has launched a new portal, accessible at csd.jnpa.in, for checking the status of container selected for scanning.

2. Checking the Container status: All stakeholders (CB, Importer/Exporter, Shipping Line, CFS, Port Terminal, etc.) can check the container status, i.e., whether the container is selected for scanning or not, and whether the container has been scanned and examined, by entering the container number, IGM number, and IGM date in the 'Check Container Status' tab of the web portal.

- (ii) Click on “**Check Container Status**” on home page




