Public Notice No. 116/2026

Subject: Streamlining movement of ICD-bound containers selected for scanning at JNCH - regarding.

At present, five container scanners are operational at JNCH for scanning of import containers selected by NCTC, comprising three Mobile Scanners (MB01, MB02 and MB03) located within the port terminals and two Drive Through Scanners (DTCS01 and DTCS02) located outside the terminals.

2. With a view to streamlining the movement of ICD-bound containers selected for scanning, it has been decided that such containers may get scanned at a Mobile Scanner, irrespective of their original allocation to a Drive Through Scanner. No further permission shall be required from the Container Scanning Division, JNCH in this regard. The objective is to ensure that the scanning of such containers is carried out within the premises of the terminal itself thereby minimizing the movement and to avoid situations wherein such containers inadvertently escape scanning.

3. It is noted here that except BMCT Terminal, all other five port terminals are conveniently located near/with a mobile scanner (MB01- JNPCT/JNFT, MB02- APMT and MB03- NSICT/NSIGT) and also well connected from within. These five terminals can avail the facility of the three Mobile Scanners to undertake scanning of ICD-bound containers.

4. In respect of ICD bound containers pertaining to the BMCT terminal, the scanning facility may be availed either through DTCS02 or through the Mobile Scanner located in close proximity to the terminal.

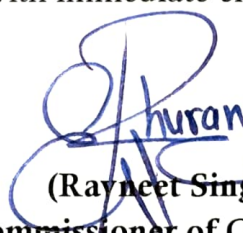
Nam 5. It may be noted that a similar arrangement has also been envisaged under
R *Public Notice No. 60/2024 dated 05th July, 2024* for operational facilitation. Considering the limited number of ICD-bound containers selected for scanning, the additional workload can be accommodated within the existing capacity of Mobile scanners.

6. Accordingly, the concerned Port Terminal Operators shall ensure that containers covered under Para 2 above are scanned at Mobile Scanner, and, in the case of BMCT, at either the nearest Mobile Scanner or DTCS02, as specified in Para 4 above, before onward movement from the terminal. Containers reported as **"Clean"** shall be released in accordance with the prescribed Customs procedure. Containers reported as **"Suspicious"** shall be moved to the nominated CFS for 100% examination in accordance with law.

7. All concerned Port Terminal Operators shall maintain appropriate records and forward a consolidated weekly report to csd.jnch@gov.in every Monday. Format of the report is attached.

8. Difficulties, if any, in implementation of this Public Notice may be brought to the notice of the Deputy/Assistant Commissioner of Customs, Container Scanning Division, JNCH.

9. This Public Notice comes into force with immediate effect.
