Public Notice No. 96/2026

Subject: Suspension of operations of M/s Aegon Shipping India Pvt. Ltd. as an Authorised Sea Agent (ASA) under Regulation 11 of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations, 2018 at JNCH(INNSA1).

Attention of the Importers/Exporters, Customs Brokers, Shipping Agents, Authorised Sea Carriers, Custodians, Container Freight Stations (CFSs), Port Terminal Operators and all other stakeholders is invited to the registration granted to M/s Aegon Shipping India Pvt. Ltd., having registered office at Shelton Cubix, Office No. 308, Plot No. 87, Sector 15, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai – 400614, as an Authorised Sea Agent (ASA) under the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations, 2018 (SCMTR, 2018). The said entity is registered under SCMTR, 2018 as an Authorised Sea Agent (ASA) at INVTZ1 (Vizag).

2. In exercise of the powers conferred under Regulation 11(2)(a) and Regulation 11(2)(c) of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations, 2018, the operations of M/s Aegon Shipping India Pvt. Ltd. within the jurisdiction of JNCH (INNSA1) have been suspended with immediate effect, vide Order of Suspension dated 10.08.2026 issued by this office, pending further inquiry and adjudication proceedings. The suspension has been ordered on account of the prima facie failure to comply with the provisions of SCMTR, 2018, particularly Regulations 10(1)(l) and 10(1)(m), and the acts/omissions attributable to the said Authorised Sea Agent which, in the opinion of the Commissioner of Customs (Gen), JNCH, render the entity unfit to transact business under the said Regulations.

3. For the sake of avoiding inconvenience to the trade and ensuring smooth clearance of cargo, all stakeholders are informed that, with effect from the date of suspension, M/s Aegon Shipping India Pvt. Ltd. shall not undertake any operations as an Authorised Sea Agent within the jurisdiction of JNCH until further orders. All concerned are advised to take note of the above suspension and regulate their transactions accordingly.

4. Notwithstanding the suspension referred to above, the following

transitional arrangements shall apply solely in respect of import and export consignments already under process as on the date of issuance of the Suspension Order:

(i) The suspension shall not invalidate any statutory declaration, manifest, amendment or transaction already accepted in the Customs automated system prior to the effective date of suspension.

(ii) In respect of import consignments where the Import General Manifest (IGM) has already been filed or cargo has already arrived prior to the effective date of suspension, clearance of such consignments may be permitted in accordance with the provisions of the Customs Act, 1962, the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transshipment Regulations, 2018 and other applicable laws, subject to completion of all Customs formalities and compliance with any specific directions issued by the proper officer.

(iii) In respect of export consignments already handed over for carriage or in respect of which Export General Manifest (EGM) related processes have commenced before the effective date of suspension, processing may be completed in accordance with law under the supervision of the proper officer, wherever considered necessary.

(iv) The suspended Authorised Sea Agent shall not accept, undertake or process any new import or export business, file any fresh statutory declarations or perform any function requiring registration under the SCMTR, 2018 within the jurisdiction of JNCH after the suspension takes effect, except to the limited extent specifically permitted in writing by the proper officer for completion of pending statutory obligations relating to consignments covered under this paragraph.

(v) Importers, exporters, Customs Brokers, custodians, terminal operators and other stakeholders dealing with pending consignments shall extend full cooperation to Customs authorities and comply with such procedural directions as may be issued from time to time for facilitating lawful completion of pending transactions.

(vi) Nothing contained in this paragraph shall be construed as revoking, modifying or diluting the Suspension Order issued under Regulation 11 of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transshipment Regulations, 2018, or as conferring any right upon the suspended Authorised Sea Agent to undertake operations beyond the limited purpose of facilitating completion of pending statutory obligations, where specifically permitted by the proper officer.
