## STANDING ORDER NO. 45/2009

Subject: Correlation of Technical Characteristics, Quality and specification of the Inputs with the Export Product under the DFIA Scheme reg.

Attention of all concerned office/staff is hereby invited to the customs Notification No. 40/2006-Cus. Dated 01.05.2006 which interalia provides that duty free import under DFIA Scheme will be subject to following condition:

(i) that the description, value and quantity of materials imported are covered by the said authorization and the said authorization is produced before the proper officer of customs at the time of clearance for debit:

Provided that in respect of resultant product specified in paragraph 4.55.3 of the Handbook of Procedures (Vol.I) of the Foreign Trade Policy, the materials permitted in the said authorization or a duty free import authorization for intermediate supply, as the case may be, shall be of the same quality, technical characteristics and specification as the materials used in the said resultant product.

Provided further that in respect of the said resultant product the exporter shall give declaration with regard to the quality, technical characteristic and specification of materials used in the shipping bill.

- II. In this connection, Trade has represented to the Board that the importers are facing difficulties in regard to clearance of material under DFIA Scheme because of insistence by the Customs to establish correlation between the imported goods and the exported product in all cases of imports under the said scheme.
- III. After due examination of the matter, the Board vide Circular No. 46/2007-Cus. Dated 20.12.2007 has clarified that except for the items specified in paragraph 4.55.3 of the Handbook of Procedures, Vol.I 2004-09, in all other cases a correlation between the inputs under import with those used in the exported product is not required to be established and that clearance under DFIA scheme may be allowed if other conditions of the Scheme and Customs notification referred to above are fulfilled.
- IV. All concerned officers/ staff are hereby directed to strictly follow the directions contained in Board s Circular No. 46/2007-Cus. Dated 20.12.2007.
- V. Difficulties if any, in following the above directions may be brought to the notice of Additional /Joint Commissioner of Customs(Export), JNCH, Uran, Raigad.
