Personal Hearing (PH) Memos and received copies of Show Cause Notices (SCNs). Personal Hearing (PH) Memos and Orders-in-Original (OlOs) dispatched through Registered Post. In several cases, parcels contained the contained by the Registered Post. In several cases, parcels containing SCNs and OlOs have been returned by the India Post to the Records Section, which is an India Post to the Records Section, which in turn returns the undelivered copies to the concerned sections. The reasons cited for non-delivery include addressee not available, address not found, addressee moved, and other similar insure. addressee moved, and other similar issues. It seems that copies of the SCNs and OIOs have not been re-send to the concerned in the alternative address available on public domain; when the same couldn't be delivered in one go.

Therefore, in order to streamline the process of issuance and delivery of SCNs, PH Memos and Orders-in-Original, the following instructions shall be strictly followed by all concerned officers of Nhava Sheva -V Commissionerate:

- Serving of SCNs, PH Memos and OIOs: Concerned Assisting Officer of the SCNs issuing authority and assisting officer to the adjudicating authority shall ensure that SCNs and OlOs are dispatched through registered post or speed post. The registered post or speed post tracking number shall be clearly recorded in the file note for future reference.
- Serving of SCNs, PH Memos and OIOs through other means: Wherever feasible, the concerned officer shall also serve the SCNs/OIOs through email or other means as ii. provided under Section 153 of Customs Act, 1962. The same should be taken on record in concerned files maintained for future reference.
- Monitoring Delivery Status: After serving the copies of SCN/OIO through post, all concerned officers shall regularly track the delivery status on the official India Post iii.
- Reporting Delivery Status: The delivery status of SCNs and OlOs shall be placed in the file within 10 days of the initial (i.e., first) dispatch through registered post or speed post. ív.
- Action in case of Non-Delivery: In case, the SCNs or OIO are not delivered after the 10 days of dispatch, the same should be recorded on file and brought to the notice of authority on that day and the print out of registered/speed post tracker is kept in file. The undelivered copies shall be kept on record and dispatched again to an alternate address of the importer/exporter/stakeholder available on record in public domain.
